

# Notice of Race for the RS600 & International Canoes At Pitsford Reservoir on Saturday 11th May & Sunday 12th May

# 1. Rules

- 1.1. The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the event supplementary sailing instructions.
- 1.2. No National Prescriptions will apply
- 1.3. Competitors should note that Northampton Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book.
- 1.4. By Entering into this event you will be a temporary member for the duration. You will therefore be governed by the club rules and bye laws as publish on our website.

# 2. Advertising

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

# 3. Conditions of Entry

- 3.1. The race is open to RS600's and International Canoes
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by Registration on the day between 8:00-10:00am
- 3.3. The race will be for a maximum of 80 boats.
- 3.4. Entrants must be members of the relevant Class Association at the time of entering.
- 3.5. Entry fee will be £30.

# 4. Schedule

- 4.1. The race start times are scheduled to be as follows with the warning signal being 5 minutes prior to the start time.
- 4.2. Launching may happen 30 mins before race start time. Safety cover will be in position when a green flag is flying above the boat house half way down the sailing club site.

#### 9. Further Information

NOTICE TO ALL VISITORS - Invasive Species Procedure.

Before launching, all competitors are required to ensure that – their boat has been 'Checked, Cleaned and Dried' for a minimum of two days prior to arriving at Northampton Sailing Club.

Before you leave you will also be required to ensure you use one of the designated wash down stations and ensure your boat is dry before going to another location.

#### ACCOMMODATION

Access will be by way of a code for the gate and changing rooms, which will be emailed to the fleet and can be obtained from the club office during the week prior to the event.


GALLEY AND BAR The bar will be open Friday 18:00-22:00 Saturday 17:00-23:00 Sunday 16:00-22:00
